Tips for Reading with Your Preschool Child

- 1. Involve your child in the process by letting them choose the book you read together.
- 2. Before reading the book look at the pictures with your child. Have your child describe what they see in the pictures.
- 3. After taking a picture walk, ask your child these prediction questions: What do you think the book will be about? Why do you think that?
- 4. As you read the story, help your child understand any unfamiliar vocabulary words.
- 5. Ask questions while reading to ensure that your child understands what is being read to them. You can ask: Who? What? Where? When? Why? How?
- 6. While reading, point out familiar letters and words. Begin by pointing out the letters in your child's name and common sight words (such as "I" & "me").
- 7. Have fun while reading. Be sure that reading time is an enjoyable time when you and your child get to bond. Finding a comfortable spot to read will make the experience more enjoyable for both of you.
