## COVID-19 Decision Tree for Parents

### Should my child go to school today?

Do you believe your child may have been in contact with an individual who tested positive for COVID-19?

**YES**

**NO**

-Stay at home  
-Inform the school  
-Call your doctor  
Clearance/note by a health care provider is preferred upon return to school after 10 day of quarantine and symptom free.

-Come to school

\*\*\*If your child tests positive for COVID-19, please inform the school and contact the LCGHD COVID-19 Hotline at (440) 350-2188 ASAP with this information. Before returning to school all three of the underlined criteria in the following box must be met.

Does your child have any of the following symptoms?  
*Loss of taste/smell, significant cough, difficulty breathing, shortness of breath, headache, chills, sore throat, shaking or exaggerated shivering, significant muscle pain/aches, or diarrhea?*

-Inform the school  
-Rest and recover  
-Call your doctor if symptoms worsen.

-Come to school

If your child has a fever with other symptoms that could be from COVID-19 and does not get tested **OR** is not cleared by your doctor, it is assumed the child has COVID-19 and may not return to school until all 3 of the following criteria are met: At least 24 hrs. have passed since recovery (No fever without the use of medication), AND child has improvement of symptoms, AND at least 10 days have passed since symptoms appeared.

Does your child have a fever of 100 or higher?

-Rest and recover  
-Call your doctor if symptoms worsen.

-Come to school

Has your child been fever free without medication for 24 hours AND not exposed to anyone who has tested positive for COVID-19?
